



Fleet Safety Roadmap

Keep your Drivers Safe, Secure, and Profitable

For DSP's it is important to keep your vehicles and fleet maintained so you can continue to deliver packages. Marsh has put together a list of questions to keep in mind as a DSP owner to keep your fleet in tip-top shape.



Start out by developing your safety policy statement, asking:

- What's my business purpose?



Consider vehicle maintenance, asking:

- What are my preventive maintenance schedules and periodic inspections?
- If repairs are needed, are rentals available to keep my business moving?
- Should I consider a replacement schedule for vehicles?
- What training am I providing my drivers to perform quality inspections of their vehicles before, during, and after their route?



Look ahead regarding post-incident procedures, asking:

- Which procedures should my staff follow at the scene of an accident?
- What's my incident review process, and what forms/photographs are needed?
- Should I offer counseling sessions and re-training options?



Think about your eligibility criteria for employees, asking:

- What kind of age and experience is right for my business?
- What motor vehicle records should I be aware of?
- What kind of road test evaluations should I consider?



Contemplate safe vehicle operation policies, asking:

- Are my seatbelts and safety restraints in proper working condition?
- What are the acceptable vehicle operating speeds?
- What are my alcohol and prescription drug-use policies?
- Should I adopt particular cell phone usage rules?
